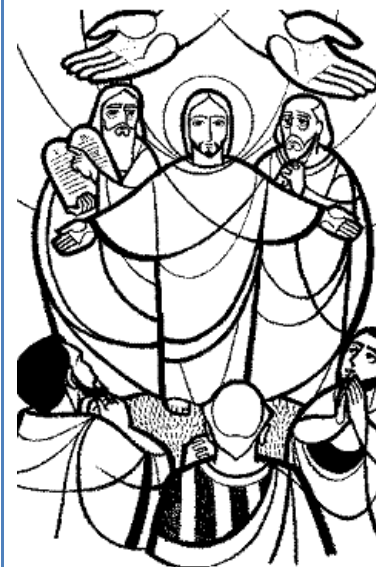

The Collect of the Day

O God,
who before the Passion of thine only-begotten Son
didst reveal his glory upon the holy mount:
Grant unto us thy servants,
that in faith beholding the light of his countenance,
we may be strengthened to bear the cross,
and be changed into his likeness from glory to glory;
through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

The Collect for Holy Name Day

O God,
who hast made the most glorious name of our Lord Jesus Christ,
thine only-begotten Son,
to be exceeding sweet and supremely lovable to thy faithful servants:
Mercifully grant that all who devoutly venerate this name of Jesus
on earth may in this life receive thy holy comfort,
and in the life to come attain thine unending joy;
through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

The Epistle

The Epistle is written in the first Chapter of the second Epistle of Peter
beginning at the sixteenth Verse.

For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto
you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his
majesty. For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there
came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in
whom I am well pleased. And this voice which came from heaven we heard,
when we were with him in the holy mount.

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

Hear endeth the Epistle.

The Gospel

The Holy Gospel is written in the ninth Chapter of Mark, beginning at the second Verse.

Glory to thee Lord Christ.

And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them. And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them. And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus. And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias. For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid. And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him. And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves. And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead. And they kept that saying with themselves, questioning one with another what the rising from the dead should mean.
